Dallas Vietty is an American jazz accordionist specializing in the Parisian swing-waltz style of Musette and Gypsy Jazz. He began playing the accordion in 2001, and has studied jazz and arranging at California State University Northridge and accordion performance with Stanley and Joanna Darrow. As a soloist, he performs widely, and won first place in the Free Bass category at the American Accordion Musicological Society Festival in 2011. As a band leader, his groups have performed at various venues, including Musikfest, Djangoary Festival, Djangofolies Festival, Djangology Festival, TEDxPhilly, Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts, and many others around the country. As an educator, he has taught at the famous music camp, Django, and has led workshops at the American Accordionists' Association Festival. Dallas has a prolific private studio and growing online teaching presence. He is one of a few who have a curriculum and knowledge of Musette and Gypsy Jazz for the piano accordion. He currently leads "Musette Project", a contemporary take on the modernist waltz compositions of the mid-century Parisian accordionists, and "Hot Bijoux", an early 20th century inspired hot swing group

DIRECTIONS TO SLEEPY HOLLOW UNITED METHODIST CHURCH:

From the Capital Beltway in Virginia: Take Route 50 East (Arlington Blvd). Go 2.2 miles. Turn right at the 4th light onto Annandale Road. Turn left at the second light onto Kerns Road. Turn right at the first light onto Sleepy Hollow Road. Go 0.6 mile. The church driveway is on the left -- it is marked with a white sign.

From 395 South: Take the exit Little River Turnpike going west. (Duke goes east -- it's the wrong way). At the first right, Beauregard Street, turn right, but stay straight, and don't curve around to the right around the liquor store. Veer left onto Lincolnia Road (Route 613). At the light turn left onto Columbia Pike (Route 244, not 712). Go about 3/4 mile and turn right onto Sleepy Hollow Rd. Go 1 mile. The church is on your right on top of the hill -- it is marked with a sign.

Going west on Columbia Pike from Bailey's Crossroads: Pass the light at Barcroft Plaza (Harris Teeters) at Lincolnia Road. Pass a light at Whispering Road and Belvedere Elementary School on the right. Turn right onto Sleepy Hollow Road. Go 1 mile. The church is on the right on top of the hill. It is marked with a white sign. (Sleepy Hollow Road is about 1-3/4 mile past Bailey's Crossroads and About 3/4 mile after Columbia Pike veers to the right where Lincolnia Road joins it on the left).
